Interview

This week we interviewed Ollie, Founder and the President of Air Ollie.

Do you think the future of Air Ollie is bright?

I think we have an incredibly bright future ahead of us. I'll never stop fighting for this airline. I am so passionate about the community I have created as well as the friends I have met along the way. It feels like a big family that I never want to let go of. I try to work as hard as I can to strive for greatness to show people what really can be accomplished on this platform with hard work and dedication. Air Ollie should in my eyes be an airline looked up to, respected and loved. Exploring Europe with an amazing and fun community with stunning planes and airports.

What changes to Air Ollie can we expect in the coming future?

You can expect a great deal of change and new innovations. Already this year we have brought out a new cabin, new menus, new uniforms and expanded so much. We will continue to improve until the airline is as perfect as it can be. I don't know when that'll be but at the moment I am having so much fun improving every bit of Air Ollie that I don't want to find out where perfect is. We plan to open some of Roblox's best airports and operate some of the best planes. We will be opening a new brand soon to replace AO Iceland. This new brand will allow us to explore so much more of Europe along side the main Air Ollie company. We plan to open 3 new airports as well as start long haul operations to reach the rest of the world. The list of changes is endless as I don't want to stop improving.

What can you tell us about the new Alesi Technology Company?

It was an idea and concept I had a while back, as a developer on Roblox I wanted one place to sell my products so that it was automated service and I could focus more on Air Ollie. The company itself was mainly created for financial reasons which I can't reveal but personally it was a new challenge that I wanted to try. The company has no specific target market but we want to help airlines in every sector in one place, from tech to planes to airports all built by myself. I love Alesi and can't wait to grow it in the future along side Air Ollie

What can you tell us about the new airports?

I currently have 3 ongoing airport projects, as follows: 1. Grímsey Island airport V2; This is an updated and completely remade version of our very popular island hop service. It will feature multiple very small island with tiny airports yet incredible little details to entice passengers. We will operate Q100 aircraft on this route as part of Air Ollie's "ícehops" brand aimed to explore the beauty of Iceland in detail. 2. Copenhagen Airport; This will be Air Ollie's long haul hub capable of holding A330-300 aircraft. The design is completely fictional and designed by me to look modern but very impressive. We will launch our first long haul operations from here as it is highly requested. The A321LR aircraft will also be launched from here. 3. London City Airport; This is my most ambitious and personal favourite project I have ever undertaken. I plan to build Roblox's best airport by creating an exact replica of the breath-taking London City Airport along with all the surrounding area of London as scenery. Current progress is going very well. We plan on releasing this for the 3-year anniversary on the 17th of May. This is unconfirmed however as these projects are huge and things do go wrong

Would you say that the working environment of the Air Ollie staff is professional or relaxed, or anything else?

I personally believe strongly that the leader makes or breaks a staff team. As someone who feels strongly about leadership I like to be looked up to as a boss and leader while at the same time being someone people can talk to as someone equal to them. Managing flights isn't easy and it's stressful, I like to keep a cool head while doing flights. We have only had only 2 flights cancelled this year, both for lack of staff. Myself and the staff work very well together and this is evident given the success rate of our flights. I like the staff to be professional as we have a very high standard to meet but I don't like it to be strict as then that isn't fun. I feel we have hit the balance perfectly as staff enjoy flights as well as doing an amazing job. I am so thankful for every staff member and the time they put into helping the airline and me. I try to show this to them at the end of flights as the airline would be nowhere without them.

What would you say the Pros and Cons of this Airline are?

I think the airline is mainly pros, we provide a service that is unique in so many ways to entertain people and help them discover. The only cons are it is hard to keep up although this for me is a pro as it keeps me busy and I love it.

What is your opinion on your team of staff and how they work?

I couldn't ask for more. We have trained our staff to be some of the best in the industry so we can meet high standards and be looked up to as an airline. Every single person plays a part in the airline. I see them as family and not just people who work for the airline.

And even though people come and go, we never forget those who truly change the airline forever. The staff are the people who make us who we are, the beating heart of the airline. They are some of the most kind, passionate and amazing people I have met and it is such a privilege to have them with me on this incredible flight path Air Ollie is on. I'd also like to add how hard Lucas works to develop this staff team into what they are. He spends hours creating documents, handbooks, spreadsheets and applications to keep the airline running like clockwork. I am so great full for Lucas as he is so kind and an amazing SHR who has come such a long way from starting out as ground crew nearly 3 years ago.

Have you encountered any problems on the road from when you started to now?

Every day is a new challenge, new people coming and going, flights to manage, people to speak to, new development. It keeps me going but I just say the first year was difficult, slow progress and nothing seemed to pay off. Nobody came to flights and nothing really happened. Funding was also a problem when we wanted to get the airline off the ground.

How have you overcome or solved the challenges?

"Never, never, never give up" - Winston Churchill. Air Ollie started out as a small idea sheep and I had in the corner of a primary school playground. Every day I kept going and put my heart and soul into the airline to make it into what it is today despite people saying I couldn't. I knew that maybe someday my hard work would pay off and I am so happy to say it did. It was worth every hour, every minute and every tear drop to get to where it is today. You can only overcome problems from not stopping trying. I never gave up and I never will give up.
